SPEAKER BIO'S & LECTURE DESCRIPTIONS AACCP CANADIAN CHAPTER



Dr. Noshir Mehta **Dentists Role in Management of Head, Neck and Face Pain**

The field of TM Disorders and Orofacial Pain is a broad field requiring an understanding of the central and peripheral nervous systems as they relate to patients in chronic pain of the head face and neck. The role of the dentist in the assessment of head, face and neck pain as they relate to maxillo-mandibular interactions will also be discussed. This lecture is also designed to provide the student with the basic concept of a three dimensional assessment of dental occlusion of an individual.

Biography

Dr. Mehta is the Director of the Craniofacial Pain Center at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine in Boston. Dr. Mehta has numerous awards and distinctions; most recently he was the recipient of the Hayden-Stack Award from the AACCP, which is presented to an individual who has demonstrated unselfish education of others and advancing the science and treatment of temporomandibular disorders and craniofacial pain.



Dr. Mariano Rocabado **Craniofacial Pain Of Cervical Origin; A Craniovertebral Centric Relation Approach Orthopaedic Manual Therapy In Synovial Temporomandibular Joint Disc Pathology.**

There are major pathological findings related to abnormal relationships between Occiput, Atlas and Axis with loss of Craniovertebral Centric Relation. This biomechanical abnormal relation can induce an abnormal pattern of growth and lead to development of the Occlusal plane and Facial Asymmetry. Acute Temporomandibular disc subluxations are common pathological conditions occurring during occlusal trauma or external mandibular trauma. These conditions can be reduced and stabilized with a musculoskeletal approach. Dr. Rocabado will address these issues and provide a physical therapy approach to the management of these dysfunctions.

Biography

Dr. Rocabado is a Doctor of Physical Therapy and a full professor at the University of Chile. He is an adjunct Professor at the University of St. Augustine in the U.S.A. Dr. Rocabado is the Dean of the Faculty of Rehabilitation Science at the University of Andres Bellow, Santiago, Chile. He has authored numerous textbooks on the topic of craniomandibular disorders as well as having written numerous peer-reviewed journal articles. He is an honorary member of both the AACCP and the AAOP.



Dr. Brendan C. Stack **Orthopedic Finishing Of The TMJ/Craniofacial Pain Patient**

Dr. Stack will show how to go from splint therapy to orthodontic case finishing on patients who had reducing and non-reducing internal derangements as well as patients who were treated surgically. Dr. Stack will demonstrate the standards for successful case treatment and finishing. At the completion of this talk attendees should be able to orthodontically restore occlusion in these patients including closing posterior open bites, identify types of internal derangements and have 7 signs of successful treatment.

Biography

Dr. Stack, an experienced international lecturer and author, is a graduate of the Georgetown University Graduate School with an M.S. in Orthodontics (1963-1965) who has been treating TMJ/TMD and craniofacial pain patients for 42 years. Dr. Stack has numerous awards and distinctions, is a founding member of the AACCP and is one of the individuals named in the Hayden-Stack Award.



Dr. Jim Beck **Restorative Phase II To Optimal Physiology**

Occlusion should not be a debate between Centric Relation or Neuromuscular Position. Occlusion should be about the Diagnosis and Treatment Plan for each individual patient and the steps necessary to establish a healthy jaw joint and function which ultimately relates to the whole human body, thus achieving Optimal Dental and Whole Body Physiology. Dr. Beck will emphasize the importance of occlusion and its' relationship to jaw and muscle stabilization. The latest technology and current research in this area will be reviewed.

Biography

Dr. Beck received his D.D.S. from Creighton University and has been in practice for 27 years. His credentials include FIAO (Fellow International Association of Orthodontics), FICCMO (Fellow, International College of Cranio-Mandibular Orthopedics), FAACP (Fellow, AACCP), DABCP (Diplomate, American Board of Craniofacial Pain).



Dr. William Hang **Connecting The Dots Between Airway, Oral Posture, Facial Balance, TMJ Health, OSA and Restorative Dentistry**

Could it be that the future of dentistry lies not only in aesthetics but also in the now emerging arena of "longevity enhancement"? Dentists are routinely restoring worn dentitions often without asking "why"? Patients suffering from Obstructive Sleep Apnea (OSA) are 6-times more likely to brux than a normal group. OSA is the most common chronic disease in all industrialized countries with 40% of adults over age 40 snoring. The connection between occlusion, TMD, OSA must be made clear to ensure that the restorative procedures dentists perform will function for the health of the patient. In this presentation, Dr. Hang will "connect the dots" for those who want to be on the cutting edge of change in dentistry.

Biography

Dr. Hang received his B.S. and D.D.S. degrees from the University of Illinois in 1970. In 1975 Dr. Hang received his M.S.D. degree in Orthodontics from the University of Minnesota and then went into private practice. Dr. Hang conducts a mini-residency teaching the Biobloc Orthotropic technique developed by Dr. John Mew of London, England. His professional affiliations include the ADA, American Association of Orthodontists, International Association for Facial Growth Guidance, AAFO and the AACCP.



Dr. Larry Wolford **Common TMJ and Jaw Problems that Cause Pain and The Surgical Management of These Conditions**

Many TMJ conditions can cause TMJ and myofascial pain, headaches, jaw and joint dysfunction. Some of these conditions can also cause progressive and unfavourable changes in the occlusion and jaw alignment. This presentation will improve the clinician's ability to recognize the most common TMJ conditions that can adversely affect patient treatment, understand the pathophysiology behind these TMJ diseases and be aware of the surgical options for specific TMJ pathologies to provide improved and predictable treatment outcomes.

Biography

Dr. Wolford graduated from Temple University School of Dentistry in 1969, and went on to the Department of Oral Surgery, University of Texas Health Science Center in Dallas, graduating in 1973. Currently Dr. Wolford is a Clinical Professor, Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Baylor College of Dentistry as well as the Director and Sponsor of the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Fellowship Program at Baylor University Medical Center and Baylor College of Dentistry.
