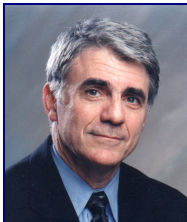

**ANDREW BLUMENFELD, MD**, is Director of the Headache Center of Southern California. A member of the American Academy of Neurology and the American Headache Society, Dr. Blumenfeld was Chief of Neurology Service at Kaiser Permanente in San Diego (1999-2004), and is past-chairman of the Hospital Bioethics Committee. Widely published, he has been an active researcher in headache and Botulinum Toxin (BOTOX®) therapy for headache disorders. Dr. Blumenfeld attended University of Witerwatersrand, Johannesburg, South Africa Medical School, and completed his Neurology Residency at the University of Massachusetts Medical School.

**BARRY H. GLASSMAN, DMD**, maintains a private practice in Allentown, PA, which is limited to chronic pain management, TMJ dysfunction and dental sleep medicine. Dr. Glassman is a resident instructor of Craniofacial Pain & Dysfunction and Dental Sleep Medicine at Lehigh Valley Hospital, Chief Dental Consultant to three other sleep centers in the Lehigh Valley, and was recently named Co-Medical Director of St. Luke's Hospital Headache Center. He hosts his own courses on pain management and sleep disorders, and has published many articles on these subjects in peer and non-peer reviewed journals.

**ANNIKA ISBERG, DDS, PhD**, Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Radiology at Umeå University, Sweden, is a certified specialist in Maxillofacial Radiology and received her PhD in 1980. Dr. Isberg's research focuses on the TMJ with special emphasis on orthopedic joint problems and sequelae. Her textbook, *Temporomandibular Joint Dysfunction: A Practitioner's Guide*, was classified as "a new 'bible' in the field of TMJ/TMD" (T. Graber, AJO), and earned the Medical Royal Society Medical Book Award 2002 and the British Medical Association (BMA) Medical Book Award 2002. Dr. Isberg was a Diplomate and Past President (1988-1995) of the Board of the Swedish Society of Maxillofacial Radiology, and a Diplomate of the Swedish Medical Research Council (1996-2000). She received the Calvin S. Case Research Award in the USA in 1995, and was honored with the first Uemura Shusaburo Memorial Lecture in Japan in 2004.

**JOEL R. SAPER, MD, FACP, FAAN**, is Founder and Director of the renowned Michigan Head Pain & Neurological Institute and Professor of Neurology at Michigan State University. Past President of the American Headache Society, Dr. Saper is board-certified in three specialties: neurology, pain medicine, and headache. He has received numerous awards throughout his career including: the Philip Lippe Public Service Award and the Distinguished Service Award from the American Academy of Pain Medicine, the John R. Graham Senior Clinician Award from the American Headache Society, and the American Council for Headache Education Lecture Award. In addition to his clinical and teaching activities, Dr. Saper is the author of seven medical books plus 200 journal articles, abstracts, and medical chapters in standard textbooks on neurology and pain.

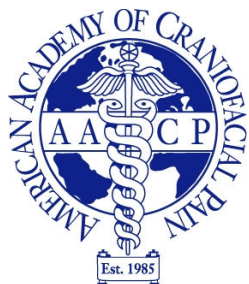

SCRIVANI, DDS, DMedSc**, is a professor at The Craniofacial Pain and Headache Center, Tufts University, New England Medical Center, Boston, MA, and Research Associate in the Pain & Analgesia Imaging and Neuroscience (PAIN) Group, Brain Imaging Center at McLean Hospital and Harvard Medical School in Boston, MA. Dr. Scrivani's clinical interests are: headache disorders, trigeminal neuralgia, neuropathic facial pain, neurological disorders, maxillofacial movement disorders, burning mouth, trigeminal nerve injuries, salivary gland disorders, and temporomandibular disorders. His research interests include functional brain imaging of pain, complementary and alternative medicine treatments for pain, clinical trials for pain, salivary biomarkers of chronic pain disorders, neuropathic pain scales and neurophysiological testing for chronic pain. A graduate of Columbia University, College of Dental Medicine (DDS, 1980) and Harvard University (DMedSc, 1993-1997), Dr. Scrivani currently serves as Secretary and Chair of the TMD, Cervical Spine & Orofacial Pain Special Interest Section of the American Headache Society.

**TERRANCE J. SPAHL, DDS**, is a Certified Senior Instructor for the IAO and serves on the Consulting Board of the TMJ Institute of America.
