## The AACP Institute's New Injection Course Covers Pain Management and Cosmetic Considerations... Perfect for Growing Your Practice!


As the Institute's Academic Director, I would like to invite you to attend our newest course, Injection Techniques: The Therapeutic Effects of Anesthetics, Steroids and Botox. This is one of the most requested courses in recent memory, especially in light of the cosmetic craze. This course will combine some of the injection techniques you may have learned in the past, along with new information utilizing Botox as an adjunctive therapy in treating craniofacial pain patients.

This multidisciplinary, two-day injection course will serve as a review of the facial muscle anatomy and neurology, along with the typical TMD and neuralgia problems where injections may be used. Other therapies (laser and electronic acupuncture) will also be explored including a discussion of how they are applicable in treating some of the more difficult patients.

Botox is an ever expanding therapeutic treatment that many offices have implemented to treat headaches and muscle problems. Although we realize that Botox shouldn't be used as an initial stand-alone treatment, it is a great adjunct therapy to the orthotic therapy that many of us use daily. Techniques used to treat migraine headaches and bruxism will be taught along with other indications and contraindications for usage. Botox treatment can also offer an esthetic or cosmetic reward for the patients, which is a very pleasing result for them.

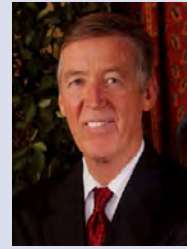
Another therapy that can be added to your practice is the use of dermal fillers to help with the esthetics for your patients. I know that this is getting away from what many of us treat daily, but we must remember that many patients these days are requesting these services, so it's good to be prepared. This exciting new Injections course will include two full days of clinical and didactic activity, and each student will have the opportunity to do each of the injections. We will also try to have models available for the Botox and dermal filler part of the class but it is better to bring someone from your home office as you can follow the results and take progressive pictures to show prospective patients.

We look forward to seeing you at the inaugural course. Be prepared for a weekend of excitement and learning. Something each of you must look at is your State Dental laws concerning Botox and fillers. Every state is different and you are responsible for making sure that you abide by those state laws.

## A New Course from the AACP that Combines Injection Techniques and the Therapeutic Effects Utilizing Anesthetics, Steroids and Botox

At long last, a course presented by the AACP — the world leader in the treatment of Craniofacial Pain — which will address all the injection techniques necessary to complement the treatment of pain patients. Registrants will also learn how Botox can be a valuable adjunctive therapy.

This new hands-on AACP Institute course includes a thorough review of head and neck anatomy and will carefully demonstrate when and where injections may be used. Each student will have the opportunity to observe the techniques, then perform the injections under close faculty supervision.

It all takes place **March 3-4, 2017**, at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel | Dallas - DFW Airport North in Irving, Texas. Instructors are Terry R. Bennett, DMD and Cameron A Kuehne, DMD, MS.

### Some of the many injections will include:

- Advanced trigger point injections for myofascial problems
- TMJ injections for unlocking, prolotherapy and diagnostic purposes
- Greater occipital injections for occipital neuralgia
- Temporalis tendon injections
- Nerve blocks for the treatment of myofascial pain, facial neuralgias and headaches
- Laser therapy for the treatment of facial pain, TMD and headaches.

The second part of the course will address the inclusion of Botulinum Toxin (Botox) as an additional therapy to treat the chronic pain patient. Techniques will include the correct muscle sites, depths of injections, proper dilutions and how to avoid, treat and manage possible side effects. The inclusion of Botox therapy will enable the practitioner to treat muscle problems, migraine headaches and bruxism problems that current modalities may miss. Safety and risk factors, along with proper evaluation of the patients will be thoroughly discussed to achieve the best therapeutic and cosmetic effects for your patient.

Dermal fillers will also be examined for the volumizing of nasolabial folds, marionette lines and deep smokers' lines around the lips. Techniques using dermal fillers for enhancements of lips and smoothing lip lines will be discussed and demonstrated.
