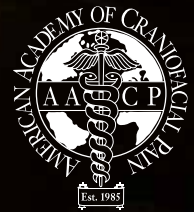

The **Craniofacial/Orofacial Pain** Board Review is a one day course. Expert, experienced faculty consisting of basic researchers, academicians and clinicians will present a board review in craniofacial/orofacial pain, TMD and Sleep Breathing Disorders. The subject matter topics will emulate the American Board of Craniofacial Pain certifying examination content areas. The course will include informative sessions on craniofacial/orofacial pain and dental sleep medicine mechanisms and evaluation. The course will also present oral case defense submission protocols and review for presentations. Faculty instructors will provide classroom setting audiovisual presentation lectures and review followed by discussion.

The subject matter topics will emulate the American Board of Craniofacial Dental Sleep Medicine (ABCSM) dental sleep medicine examination content areas. The course will include informative sessions on dental sleep medicine and sleep medicine mechanisms and evaluation. Supplemental case selection and submission protocols will be reviewed. Faculty instructors will provide classroom setting audiovisual presentation lectures and review followed by discussion.

- F.** Supplemental case selection submission review.

Jeanne K. Bailey, DDS

Jeanne K. Bailey, DDS received her doctor of dental surgery degree from West Virginia University School of Dentistry in 1983. She has served as Adjunct Clinical Professor at West Virginia University and volunteer Assistant Professor at Marshall University Health, Dentistry and Oral Surgery Program. Dr. Bailey is very active in the American Academy of Craniofacial Pain and has served on the AACP Board of Directors holding the positions of AACP Treasurer, Credentialing Chair, Educational Committee, and Finance/Budget Committee Chair. She is the first female to receive AACP Fellowship status. She has been instrumental in creating psychometric credentialing standards in the field of Craniofacial Pain, Temporomandibular Joint Disorders and Sleep Breathing Disorders. She serves as Examination Committee Chair for the American Board of Craniofacial Pain, served as President of the ABCP, and now serves as ABCP Immediate Past President. She is a founding member of the American Board of Craniofacial Dental Sleep Medicine, former ABCDSM Examination Co-Chair and current ABCDSM Treasurer. Dr. Bailey has attained several certification including ABCP Diplomate (DABCP), ABCDSM Diplomate (DABCDMSM), American Board of Dental Sleep Medicine Diplomate (DABDSM) and American Academy of Pain Management Diplomate (DAAPM). Dr. Bailey currently works as a clinical practitioner with WV Sleep and TMJ Treatment Center and is co-owner of Wolpert Farms.

Deepak Shrivastava, MD

Deepak Shrivastava, a 1974 medical school graduate, further trained at Brooklyn Jewish hospital, State University of New York and University of California at Davis. He received his Sleep Medicine training at Stanford University with Dr. Christian Guilleminault and Dr. Alex clerk in 1989. He is board certified in Sleep Medicine, Pulmonary Medicine, Critical Care Medicine, Internal Medicine, Post-Acute Care Medicine and Polysomnography Technology. He is affiliated with University of California, Davis School of Medicine, and is a Fellow of American Academy of Sleep Medicine, Fellow of American College of Chest Physicians, Fellow of American College of Physicians and American Federation for Clinical Research. Dr. Shrivastava is recipient of many

academic and service awards, including Medical Director of the Year Award 2015 and Life Time Achievement Award 2015. He is a Professor of Internal Medicine, Sleep Medicine, Pulmonary and Critical Care at UC Davis School of Medicine and Chief of Sleep, Critical Care and Pulmonary Services at San Joaquin General Hospital. He is an Adjunct Professor of Pharmacy at University of Pacific, School of Pharmacy and Assistant Professor of Medicine at St. George's School of Medicine. He is an Assistant Professor of Medicine at School of Osteopathic Medicine in Vallejo, California and is a senior faculty at Sleep Medicine Fellowship Program at UC Davis.

H. Clifton Simmons III, DDS

H. Clifton Simmons III, DDS received his degree in 1977 from the University of Tennessee, College of Dentistry. He is currently an assistant clinical professor in the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Department at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine. He has held this appointment for 25 years. He is also an assistant professor at the University of Tennessee, College of Dentistry. He has a private practice in Nashville, Tennessee, which is 85% diagnosis and treatment of craniofacial pain and TM disorders and 15% general dentistry. Dr. Simmons is a Diplomate of the American Board of Craniofacial Pain and the American Board of Orofacial Pain. Dr. Simmons is a Fellow of the American College of Dentists, the International College of Dentists, the American Academy of Craniofacial Pain, the American Academy of Orofacial Pain, the Tennessee Dental Association, the Academy of General Dentistry, the Pierre Fauchard Academy and the Academy of Dentistry International. He is the editor of the Journal of the Tennessee Dental Association and the International College of Dentists USA Section. He is the TMJ/Craniofacial Editor for the Journal of Craniofacial Practice and on the editorial board of the Journal of the American College of Dentists. Dr. Simmons is the recipient of the Tennessee Academy of General Dentistry 2007 Dentist of the Year Award and is a Past President of the Tennessee Dental Association. He is the recipient of the 2017 Jack Wells Memorial Dedication to Dentistry Award, the highest award given by the TDA. He is currently the president of the American Association of Dental Editors and Journalists.
