

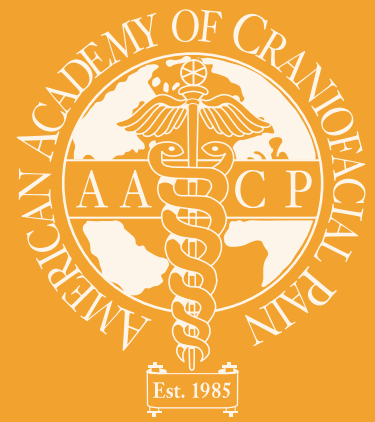
Injection Techniques & Prolotherapy

This fall, the AACP presents a hands-on training course where you can learn cutting-edge injection techniques for the therapeutic treatment of patients who want to feel better and look better. After participating in this dynamic two-day course, you'll return to your practice prepared to introduce procedures that will immediately grow your bottom line! But you must act quickly—registration is strictly limited in order to preserve a sound faculty-student ratio.

A stellar faculty has been assembled to provide you with a rare opportunity to learn both the background didactic and hands-on application of these vital skills for the treatment of chronic facial pain, TMD, headaches and neuropathic pain. The three main course instructors and program developers are **Dr. Ronald Auvenshine**, who will provide all anatomical training; **Dr. Mark Cantieri**, who will examine prolotherapy and **Drs. Jeff McCarty** and **Jeanne K. Bailey**, who will oversee the injection and practical skills portion of the course.

As a bonus, we have added a half-day program focusing on prolotherapy. Teaching objectives include the history of prolotherapy, an understanding of the various solutions used in prolotherapy, an understanding of the rationale for prolotherapy treatment protocols, an understanding of coding and billing processes for prolotherapy and—perhaps most importantly – hands-on competence with injections in the temporomandibular joint, the stylomandibular ligament, the occipital tendons and the sternocleidomastoid tendons utilizing prolotherapy.

Your instructor for this segment of the program is **Dr. Mark Cantieri**, who earned his doctor of osteopathic medicine degree from the Des Moines University College of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery. Since 1993 he has been in private practice operating Corrective Care, PC, which specializes in the treatment of chronic musculoskeletal pain disorders. In 2018, he co-authored the medical textbook, *Principles of Prolotherapy*. He has been active throughout his career teaching osteopathic manipulation and prolotherapy both nationally and internationally.
