Working in small groups, participants will be guided by course faculty in state-of-the-art patient examination techniques, impression and record taking, fitting and adjusting oral appliances that are marketed for sleep-disordered breathing, and in the identification and management of side effects.

#### Learn How to:

- ▶ Evaluate patients for oral appliance therapy and to take the required bite records
- ▶ Deliver oral appliances, and assess and modify their fit to the teeth
- ▶ Adjust oral appliances to optimize their efficacy
- ▶ Identify and minimize side effects of oral appliance therapy
- ▶ Exam TMJ and masticatory muscles in the evaluation and treatment of patients with oral appliances
- ▶ Incorporate DSM in your practice
